Please Note: After installation extra hardware and accessories are possible due to our kits are used on multiple products and options.

To Install Canopy (Figure 1)

CAUTION: BE SURE POWER IS OFF AT THE MAIN BREAKER BOX PRIOR TO INSTALLATION.

1. Carefully unpack the fixture from the carton.

To attach canopy (A) directly to the junction box: Thread the wires in the electrical box through the hole in the canopy (A) while moving the canopy into position. Using two machine screws (not provided) fasten canopy (A) to the electric box.

Note: A new electrical box comes with screws. When replacing a fixture, retain the existing screws for use with the new fixture.


- Remove nut (E) from stud on canopy cover plate (B).
 Slide end of safety cable over stud and reattach nut (E).
 The safety cable also acts as a ground for the canopy cover plate (B)
- 3. Using suitable wire connectors (not provided) connect transformer wires to supply wires (white to white and black to black). Connect all ground wires (bare copper or green to bare copper or green) together

Note: Grey and purple driver wires are not used for this fixture.

CAUTION: MAKE SURE WIRE CONNECTORS ARE TWISTED ON SECURELY AND NO BARE WIRE IS EXPOSED.

Install canopy cover plate (B) making sure the (+) and

 (-) labels on the cover are aligned with the labels on the canopy (A). Secure in place with cap (C).



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To Complete Installation (Figure 2)

- 1. Align (+) and (-) labels on fixture (G) with (+) and (-) labels on canopy.
- 2. Slide gripper lock (I) onto support/supply cable (D).

Note: Gripper locks (I) are shipped in kit bag.


- 3. Insert support/supply cable (D) through gripper (H) until cable sticks through slot in side of gripper (H).
- 4. Repeat steps 2 & 3 with remaining cables (D).
- 5. Continue pulling cables (D) through grippers (H) until desired fixture height is achieved making sure to keep fixture level.

Note: If fixture needs to be lowered, push down on top of the canopy gripper to release cable.

6. Once desired height of the fixture(G) is achieved, thread gripper lock (I) back onto gripper (H) and cut off the excess cable (D) as close to the gripper (H) as possible.

CAUTION: BE SURE THAT NO PIECE OF THE SUPPORT CABLE IS TOUCHING THE FIXTURE

CAUTION: ONCE EXCESS CABLE IS CUT, FIXTURE CANNOT BE LOWERED
